Coaches Code of Conduct

Coaches are encouraged to adhere to the codes of coaching conduct as advised by the ECB Coaches Code of Conduct. The main principles are:

- Rights – Coaches must respect and champion the rights of every individual to participate in cricket
- Relationships – Coaches must develop a relationship with cricketers (and others) based on openness, honesty, mutual trust and respect
- Responsibilities - personal standards – Coaches must demonstrate proper personal behaviour and conduct at all times
- Responsibilities - professional standards – To maximise benefits and minimise the risks to cricketers, coaches must attain a high level of competence through qualifications and a commitment to ongoing training that ensures safe and correct practice
